PE and Sport Premium Funding.

Every year I have the opportunity to meet up with fellow PE and Sports people from Primary and Secondary Schools across the County at the annual Cornwall PE Conference. This is where new initiatives, thoughts, ideas and funding are introduced alongside the latest health focusses.

For another year, primary schools are extremely fortunate to receive the Government funding for PE and Sport, with the added funding for this year of the 'Sugar Tax'. This initiative has been added to promote healthy active lifestyles amongst young children, where obesity is rapidly on the increase. The main focus is that children are ACTIVE for at LEAST 60 minutes A DAY, 30 minutes during school time and 30 minutes at home. Is your child achieving this?

Each year an action plan is created, following a very stringent criteria, on how our school will spend this money (this can be found on our school website – PE and Sport). The actions have to show how they can be sustained if/when the funding stops.

Below is an example of how this year we plan to use some of our funding...

- 6 Gymnastics sessions per class at Pz Gym Club for children in KS1,
- 6 surfing sessions for children who can swim 25m in Years 5 & 6
- 6-10 swimming sessions for Years 3 & 4 with the inclusion of intensive swim sessions for children who are unable to swim a recognisable stroke for 25m.
- Specialised coaching staff Harry, who helps in the organisation of Intrasport competitions during lunchtimes and teaches 4 classes on a rotation over two afternoons plus 2 after school clubs. Justin Stephens as football and cricket coach.
- Balanceability for Reception/Year 1 children (possible purchase of balance bikes and training a member of staff to carry out the programme)
- Entry into various sporting events throughout the competition calendar year.
- Maintenance and running costs of School Minibuses, enabling us to transport children to swimming, gymnastics and other sporting events.

At St Hilary we are very fortunate to not only have our sports field, court and playground but also staff and parent volunteers willing to give up their time for extra-curricular activities and competitions. Our children, who are always up for a challenge, are an absolute credit to themselves, families and school at all sporting events having the confidence to give sports a go at various levels.

This term we have a wide variety of clubs on offer every day of the week, which are now well underway!

Last but not least we have just received the great news that St Hilary have been awarded GOLD for the Sports Games Mark 2016/2017. There is a huge list of objectives and criteria to achieve for the gold standard throughout the year. The list for this academic year has already begun so fingers crossed for gold again!



Many thanks for your continued support, I am very much looking forward to what this year has to offer on the sports front and I'm sure St Hilary will continue to leave their positive sporting attitude wherever they go! Let's go team St Hilary!
