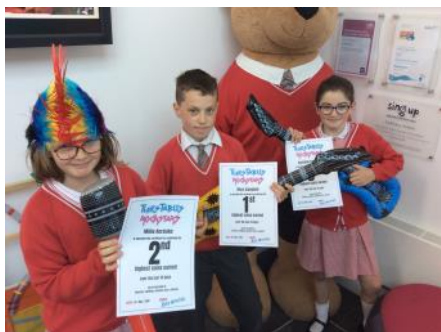
### TTRockstars
