DATA COLLECTION

With the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that came into effect in May 2018, we now have new requirements around the way we use pupil and parent data. We have moved to the SIMS Parent Lite app for this purpose as it helps us comply with these new requirements, by providing a simple way to collect, manage and handle information by obtaining accurate data securely from our parents.

Therefore we will no longer be sending out the paper Data Collection forms that you previously received each Autumn term to check the information held on our computer system. If there are any parents who do not have an email address then you can come in to school and we will provide you with a paper copy, but we are unable to send this home with a child.

The Parent Lite app means you can provide us with additional information on crucial details such as medical information or dietary requirements, new mobile numbers etc using the text information function. In order to add/amend the information held for your child you will need to register for the app. This is done from an email that we sent recently, and if possible please could you register by the end of this term. If you have already registered from the first invitation that went out in April, as a number of you have, **please do not go through the process again**.

The app is available on iOS, Android and a browser, the SIMS Parent Lite app provides a convenient and accessible solution for you to electronically review and request changes to the data held on you and your children. This week's 'Hot Chocolate Friday' winners!


