only 3 weeks, the growth in the children's skills and confidence has been outstanding and it has been amazing to see so many smiling faces and hear so many laughs and jokes.

Our science focus incorporates how humans, animals and plants change, grow and reproduce. The level of work that

has been produced so far has been incredible!

Linking to our science this term, our PSHE topic has now moved on to discuss 'Changing Me.' The children were honest, kind and thoughtful as we explored our own self-image last week and I am hopeful that this attitude to learning continues as we tackle some of the more challenging subjects over the next few weeks.

As we move towards the end of term, and a very challenging school year, we want to try and create some legacy artwork within the school. We will be creating art work with household plastic waste and other recyclables, with the view to creating a sculpture for Ellie's Garden.
