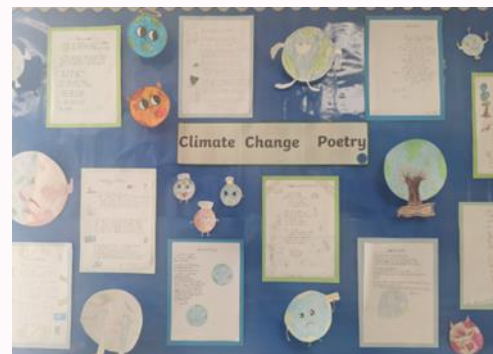
GWENVER CLASS UPDATE

Gwenver class are now half way through our topic, 'Is there a plan(et) B or should we go with the flow?' and they have shown how passionate they are about looking after the world around them.

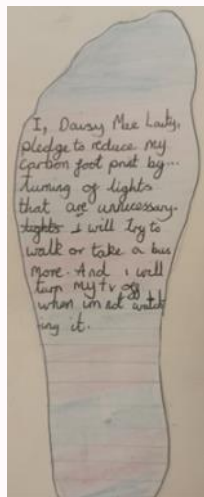
We have been learning about our carbon footprint, thinking about where our food and clothes come from and learning about the importance of global trade links and the impact and effect this has on the environment. Our writing work has centred around these ideas with the children producing some beautiful climate change poetry and creating fact files about the Suez Canal.

We have also learned about different types of energy, which included our beautiful (albeit long!) walk to Mrs Ballard's house when we visited solar panels and a wind turbine. The children created some beautiful sketches and have learned about the advantages and disadvantages of different types of energy.



As we have a geography focus this term, we have just finished reading 'The Fastest Boy in the World,' which features a boy in Ethiopia who loved to run. This has enabled the children to think about different cultures and lifestyles and compare them to day to day life in Cornwall.



In our PE lessons, we have been playing cricket and rounders but the highlight has been surfing with Gwenver class. After only 3 weeks, the growth in the children's skills and confidence has been outstanding and it has been amazing to see so many smiling faces and hear so many laughs and jokes.

Our science focus incorporates how humans, animals and plants change, grow and reproduce. The level of work that has been produced so far has been incredible!

Linking to our science this term, our PSHE topic has now moved on to discuss 'Changing Me.' The children were honest, kind and thoughtful as we explored our own self-image last week and I am hopeful that this attitude to learning continues as we tackle some of the more challenging subjects over the next few weeks.



As we move towards the end of term, and a very challenging school year, we want to try and create some legacy artwork within the school. We will be creating art work with household plastic waste and other recyclables, with the view to creating a sculpture for Ellie's Garden. Thank you to the parents who have already started sending in their plastic recycling!!
