This week the school has celebrated St Piran's Day with great gusto!



On Monday night, the Junior St Piran's Choir attended a concert at St John's Hall. The children performed magnificently and were highly praised by all involved. Notably, people commented on the size and the enthusiasm of the choir, the quality of their singing and their impressive volume, which really lifted the performance – fantastic job singers, and of course our choir leader Mrs Eddy. In addition, can we say a heart-felt thanks to the parents who supported this event, as without you it simply couldn't have taken place.

Then on the Tuesday – St Piran's Day itself – Lamorna Class (Year 6) and the school band took to the streets of Penzance to celebrate in traditional style with a 'Furry' right through the heart of the town. The children were an absolute credit to the school and performed with real enthusiasm, style and great humour – the smiles didn't stop all

morning, and it is a long time to skip, hop, rotate, play an instrument and hold hands! After parading through the streets, the procession gathered in Morrab Gardens at the bandstand.

In the gardens, the school band had a great opportunity to play with The Golowan Band and bands from other local primary and secondary schools, in the bandstand itself. Obviously, I might be slightly biased, but they were brilliant, especially, as when playing the tunes with the extended band, they were expected to be laying at a much faster pace! It is also worth giving special praise to the younger band members here – it was great to see band members from each of the junior classes! However, this wasn't just an opportunity for the band, as all of the procession joined in with some traditional Cornish singing – The Song of the Western Men (Trelawny) and of course finished off with a raucous Oggy-oggy-oggy (not forgetting the Oi, Oi, Oi!)

After returning to St John's Hall, the children had a saffron bun and brief rest before returning to school for lunch. And what a great job Hilary and the kitchen staff did in preparing a pasty and heavy cake feast for the school – the lunch hall was as quiet as it has ever been, lots of satisfied customers identifiable only by their rustling of the paper pasty bags!

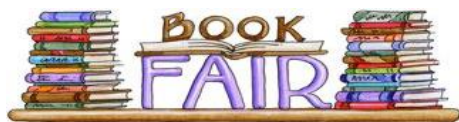

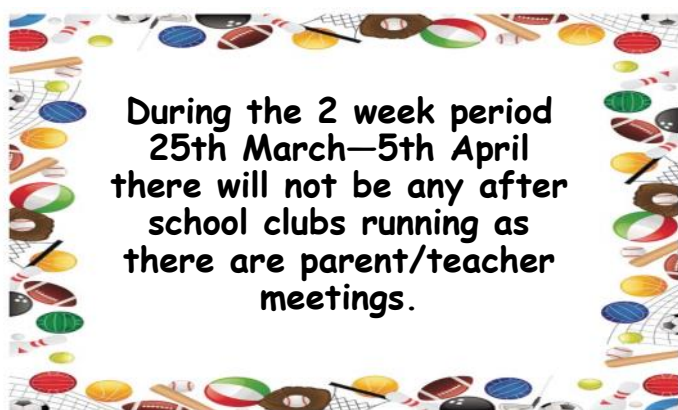
We are holding a book fair in the old Gwithian classroom on Thursday 14th March & Tuesday 19th March from 3 p.m. - 4.30 p.m.
