Science In School

As Science leader at St Hilary school, I am always on the look-out for ways to make Science 'fun' and enjoyable for the children, but also allow teachers to be confident in delivering exciting lessons!

I have for a couple of years (thanks to Covid we took an extra year to complete it), been taking part in a research group, trialling a new way to deliver science. Having finally completed the research at the end of last term with Miss Reynolds, we are now in the process of introducing teachers at St Hilary to the exciting planning and assessments available to us now.

It ensures we allow more hands-on science, more real life investigations and more experiments all the time allowing the teacher to assess each area of science that we deliver to the children in more depth. To make sure that this is possible, each teacher will only focus on one part of a Science lesson. The teacher will then be able to concentrate on any misconceptions that there may be within the lesson. Likewise, this gives the chance for the teacher to extend a child's learning, understanding and knowledge.

It also gives the teacher the opportunity to take their time teaching Science. Setting up a meaningful experiment or investigation will undoubtedly be more beneficial when more than one lesson is spent on covering an experiment or investigation while we are guaranteeing the children fully understand what they are doing.

Teaching in this way gives the teacher confidence to take ownership of each lesson and ensures that the pupils are receiving exciting, hands on Science lessons at St Hilary School.

Finally, I am looking forward to seeing Science lessons across the school evolve, and will be informing you of the progress later in the academic year.


